AN ACT SEPARATING THE SOUTHERN PHILIPPINES AGRI-BUSINESS AND MARINE AQUATIC SCHOOL OF TECHNOLOGY (SPAMAST) HIGH SCHOOL – TICULON ANNEX IN BARANGAY TICULON, MUNICIPALITY OF MALITA, PROVINCE OF DAVAO DEL SUR FROM THE SPAMAST HIGH SCHOOL AND CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS THE TICULON NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. *Separation and Conversion into a National High School.*
- 2 – The Southern Philippines Agri-Business and Marine Aquatic School of
- 3 Technology (SPAMAST) High School – Ticulon Annex in Barangay Ticulon,
- 4 Municipality of Malita, Province of Davao del Sur is hereby separated from
- 5 the SPAMAST High School and converted into an independent national high
- 6 school to be known as the Ticulon National High School.

1 SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,
2 liabilities and records of the SPAMAST High School – Ticulon Annex are
3 hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Ticulon National High School.

4 SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall
5 immediately include in the Department’s program the operationalization of the
6 Ticulon National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged
7 against the current year’s appropriations of the SPAMAST High School –
8 Ticulon Annex in Barangay Ticulon. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the
9 continued operation of the school shall be included in the annual General
10 Appropriations Act.

11 SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue such
12 rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

13 SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
14 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
