AN ACT DECLARING SEPTEMBER 20 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN ILIGAN CITY TO CELEBRATE THE TOURISM WEEK OF THE CITY AND TO HONOR THE FEAST OF SAINT MICHAEL ARCHANGEL, PATRON SAINT OF THE CITY

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. September 20 of every year is hereby declared a special nonworking holiday in Iligan City in observance of the celebration of the Tourism Week of Iligan City and to honor the Feast of St. Michael Archangel, patron saint of the city.
 - SEC. 2. On this day, all officials, city and national government agencies or instrumentalities, civic, religious and other nongovernment organizations, including private companies, shall recognize it as a day of celebration. The city government shall lead the appropriate activities.

- 1 SEC. 3. All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations and other
- 2 issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with or contrary to any
- 3 provision of this Act are hereby deemed repealed, amended or modified
- 4 accordingly.
- 5 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
