AN ACT STRENGTHENING FURTHER AND BROADENING THE COVERAGE OF THE SPECIAL PROGRAM FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENTS (SPES), AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7323

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Republic Act No. 7323, otherwise known as the Special Program for the Employment of Students (SPES), is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, [any] persons or entit[y]IES employing [at least fifty (50)] MORE THAN TEN (10) persons may [during the summer and/or Christmas vacations] employ poor but deserving students fifteen (15) years of age but not more than twenty-five (25) years old, paying them a salary or wage not lower than the minimum wage [provided by law and other applicable labor

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rules and regulations FOR PRIVATE EMPLOYERS AND THE APPLICABLE HIRING RATE FOR THE NATIONAL AND LOCAL COVERNMENT AGENCIES: PROVIDED. THAT STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE SECONDARY LEVEL SHALL ONLY BE EMPLOYED DURING SUMMER AND/OR CHRISTMAS VACATIONS. WHILE THOSE ENROLLED IN TERTIARY, VOCATIONAL OR TECHNICAL EDUCATION MAY BE EMPLOYED AT ANY TIME OF THE YEAR: PROVIDED. FURTHER, THAT THEIR PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT SHALL BE FROM TWENTY (20) TO FIFTY-TWO (52) WORKING DAYS ONLY, WHICH MAY BE COUNTED AS PART OF THE STUDENTS' PROBATIONARY PERIOD SHOULD THEY APPLY IN THE SAME COMPANY OR AGENCY AFTER GRADUATION: PROVIDED. FINALLY. THAT STUDENTS EMPLOYED IN ACTIVITIES RELATED TO THEIR COURSE MAY EARN EQUIVALENT ACADEMIC CREDITS AS MAY DETERMINED BY THE APPROPRIATE GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.

"For purposes of this Act, poor but deserving students refer to those whose parents' combined income[s], together with their [income] OWN, if any, does not exceed [Thirty-six thousand pesos (P36,000.00) per annum] THE ANNUAL REGIONAL POVERTY THRESHOLD LEVEL FOR A FAMILY OF SIX (6) AS MAY BE DETERMINED BY THE NATIONAL ECONOMIC AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (NEDA) FOR THE PRECEDING YEAR. Employment [should be at the Labor Exchange Center of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE)] FACILITATION SERVICES FOR APPLICANTS TO THE PROGRAM SHALL BE DONE BY THE PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT SERVICE OFFICE (PESO).

| 12 | education[.]: PROVIDED, THAT LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS |
| 13 | (LGUs) MAY ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR PAYING IN FULL |
| 14 | THE SALARY OR WAGES OF THE STUDENTS. The amount of the |
| 15 | education vouchers shall be paid by the [G]Government to the |
| 16 | educational institutions concerned within thirty (30) days from |
| 17 | [its] presentation to the officer or agency designated by the |
| 18 | Secretary of Finance. |
| 19 | "The vouchers shall not be transferable except when the |
| 20 | payees thereof die[s] or for a justifiable cause stop[s] in [his |
| 21 | duties] THEIR EDUCATION, in which case [it] THESE can be |
| 22 | transferred to [his] THEIR brothers or sisters. If there be none, |
| 23 | the amount thereof shall be paid [his] TO THEIR heirs or to the |
| 24 | payees [himself] THEMSELVES, as the case may be." |
| 25 | SEC. 3. Section 3 of the same Act is hereby amended to read as |
| 26 | follows: |

| 1 | "SEC. 3. The Secretary of Labor and Employment, the |
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| 2 | Secretary of Education, [Culture and Sports] THE CHAIRMAN OF |
| 3 | THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION, THE SECRETARY |

| 5 | WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT and the Secretary of Finance |
| 6 | shall issue the corresponding rules and regulations to carry out |

| 8 | "The Secretary of Labor and Employment shall be the |
| 9 | [Project Director of this] program CHAIRMAN." |
| 10 | SEC. 4. Section 4 of the same Act is hereby amended to read as |
| 11 | follows: |
| 12 | "SEC. 4. [Any p]Persons or entit[y]IES who shall make |
| 13 | any fraudulent or fictitious claim under this Act, regardless of |
| 14 | whether payment has been made, AND PERSONS OR ENTITIES |
| 15 | WHO REFUSE TO HONOR EDUCATION VOUCHERS, shall upon |
| 16 | conviction be punished with imprisonment of not less than six |
| 17 | (6) months and not more than one (1) year and a fine of not less |
| 18 | than Ten thousand pesos (P10,000.00), without prejudice to their |
| 19 | prosecution and punishment for any other offense punishable |
| 20 | under the Revised Penal Code or any other penal statute. |
| 21 | "In case of partnerships or corporations, the managing |
| 22 | partner, general manager, or chief executive officer, as the case |
| 23 | may be, shall be criminally liable." |
| 24 | SEC. 5. Section 5 of the same Act is hereby amended to read as |
| 25 | follows: |
| 26 | "SEC. 5. [The amount necessary to carry out the purposes |
| 27 | of this Act is hereby authorized to be appropriated in the General |

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| 2 . | appropriations acts.] THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT |

| 12 | SEC. 6. If any provision or part of this Act, or the application thereof to |
| 13 | any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of |
| 14 | this Act or the application of such provision or part thereof to other persons or |
| 15 | circumstances shall not be affected thereby. |

SEC. 7. All laws, orders, issuances, rules and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

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SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of national circulation, whichever comes earlier.
