## HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

LOCATED CHANNEL LIMAHONG MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN A TOURIST

SPOT AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled: '

SECTION 1. The Limahong Channel located in the Municipality of Lingayen, 1

Province of Pangasinan, is hereby declared a tourist spot. As such, its development shall 2

be prioritized by the Department of Tourism (DOT), subject to the rules and regulations

governing the development of tourist spots.

THE

Sec. 2. Within six (6) months after the approval of this Act, the DOT, in 5 coordination with the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority and 6

concerned agencies of the government, shall prepare a tourism development plan 7

containing, among others, the construction, installation and maintenance of such 8

appropriate facilities and infrastructure that shall encourage tourism in the area, including

a tourism center, to be known as the Limahong Channel Tourism Center, that shall serve

as a museum to display artifacts and historic articles related to the Limahong settlement

- 1 in the area: Provided, That said development plan shall ensure the preservation and
- 2 conservation of the natural beauty and historical significance thereof.
- Sec. 3. The DOT shall take immediate steps to implement the development plan
- 4 and incorporate the same in its tourism development program for the ensuing calendar
- 5 year.
- Sec. 4. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's program the
- 7 implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General
- 8 Appropriations Act and from internally generated funds of the DOT.
- 9 Sec. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Secretary of the
- 10 DOT shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for its proper implementation.
- Sec. 6. This act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
- 12 Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
