AN ACT DECLARING MASUNGI GEORESERVE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BARAS, PROVINCE OF RIZAL, AN ECOTOURISM DESTINATION, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Masungi Georeserve in the Municipality of Baras, Province of Rizal,
 is hereby declared an ecotourism destination. As such, its development shall be prioritized by the
 Department of Tourism (DOT), subject to the rules and regulations governing the development
 of ecotourism destinations.

5 SEC. 2. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the DOT, in consultation with 6 the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Department of Public Works and 7 Highways, Department of the Interior and Local Government, other concerned government 8 agencies, local government units (LGUs) and civil society organizations, shall prepare an 9 ecotourism development plan including the construction, installation and maintenance of such 10 appropriate facilities and infrastructure that shall enhance, develop and promote ecotourism in 11 the area, and improve accessibility and ensure the security of tourists: *Provided*, That said

development plan shall ensure the preservation, conservation and optimum utilization of
 available assets and resources in the area.

SEC. 3. The DOT, in coordination with all concerned government agencies and LGUs,
shall take immediate steps to implement the development plan and incorporate the same in its
tourism development program for the ensuing calendar year. It shall also include the Masungi
Georeserve in all its national, regional and local promotions programs.

SEC. 5. The Secretaries of the DOT and DENR shall include in their respective
Department's program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in
the annual General Appropriations Act and shall augment such allocation with internally
generated funds of the DOT.

SEC. 6. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the DOT shall promulgate
 the necessary rules and regulations for the proper implementation of this Act.

SEC. 7. All laws, rules, regulations, executive orders, proclamations, presidential decrees
 and other issuances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby deemed
 repealed or amended accordingly.

SEC. 8 If, for any reason, any section or provision of this Act is held unconstitutional or
 invalid, the other sections or provisions hereof shall not be affected thereby.

18 SEC. 9. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official
19 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
