## AN ACT

DECLARING APRIL 27 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NON-WORKING PUBLIC HOLIDAY THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY TO BE KNOWN AS "LAPU-LAPU DAY" IN COMMEMORATION OF THE VICTORY OF LAPU-LAPU AND HIS MEN OVER THE SPANIARDS LED BY FERDINAND MAGELLAN IN THE HISTORIC BATTLE OF MACTAN ON APRIL 27, 1521, REPEALING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11040

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. April 27 of every year is hereby declared a special non-working public holiday throughout the country to be known as "Lapu-Lapu Day" in commemoration of the victory of Lapu-Lapu and his men over the Spaniards led by Ferdinand Magellan in the historic Battle of Mactan on April 27, 1521.
- SEC. 2. Republic Act No. 11040, and all other laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
  - **SEC. 3.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
