AN ACT

CONVERTING THE BAY DISTRICT HOSPITAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAY, PROVINCE OF LAGUNA INTO A GENERAL HOSPITAL, TO BE KNOWN AS THE LAGUNA REGIONAL HOSPITAL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Bay District Hospital in the Municipality of Bay, Province of Laguna, is hereby converted into a general hospital to be known as the Laguna Regional Hospital which shall be under the direct supervision and control of the Department of Health (DOH).

SEC. 2. Any future increase in bed capacity shall be consistent with the hospital
development plan which shall be prepared by the Chief of Hospital of the Laguna
Regional Hospital and submitted to the DOH.

9 10 SEC. 3. The existing professional health care services and facilities of the 11 Laguna Regional Hospital are also hereby upgraded to conform with and be 12 commensurate to the increase in bed capacity as provided for in Section 2 hereof.

SEC. 4. The existing workforce of the Laguna Regional Hospital, which includes doctors, nurses, and support personnel, shall be increased correspondingly. The Secretary of the DOH shall, after consultation with the Chief of the Laguna Regional Hospital, and in coordination with the Secretary of the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and the Chairperson of the Civil Service Commission, determine the additional new positions to be created and filled up.

SEC. 5. The Secretary of the DOH shall immediately include in the Department's program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act. 1 SEC. 6. If any provision or part of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the 2 remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SEC. 7. All laws, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations inconsistent
with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

7 **SEC. 8.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the 8 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
