AN ACT.

DECLARING THE CITY OF SAN PABLO, PROVINCE OF LAGUNA, AN ECOTOURISM DESTINATION, TO BE KNOWN AS THE "CITY OF SEVEN LAKES", AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The City of San Pablo, Province of Laguna, is hereby declared an
 ecotourism destination and shall be known as the "City of Seven Lakes".

- Sec. 2. The Department of Tourism (DOT), in coordination with the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA), the provincial government of Laguna, the city government of San Pablo and other concerned agencies of the government, shall prepare a tourism development plan that shall include the construction, installation and maintenance of such appropriate facilities and infrastructure that shall enhance tourism, improve accessibility and ensure the safety of the people in the area.
- 9 Sec. 3. The DOT shall take immediate steps to implement the tourism development plan
 10 and incorporate the same in its tourism development program for the ensuing calendar year.
- 11 Sec. 4. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's program the 12 implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General

1 Appropriations Act, and shall augment such allocation with internally generated funds of the

2 Department.

3 Sec. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the DOT shall promulgate
4 the necessary rules and regulations for the proper implementation of this Act.

5 Sec. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official
6 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
