AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE RANK CLASSIFICATION AND ORGANIZATION OF KEY POSITIONS IN THE BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION (BFP) AND BUREAU OF JAIL MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY (BJMP), AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9263, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION AND BUREAU OF JAIL MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY PROFESSIONALIZATION ACT OF 2004", AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9592, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Republic Act No. 9263 or the "Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP) Professionalization Act of 2004" provides that "uniformed personnel of the BFP and the BJMP, as members of the uniformed service of the government under the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), are required the same amount of sacrifice, service and dedication like their counterparts in the Philippine National Police (PNP) and the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) to carry out their respective duties to the extent of risking their lives and limbs."

Recognizing their complementary role and valuable contribution in the maintenance of peace and order, protection of life, liberty and property and the promotion of the general welfare, the BFP and the BJMP deserve equal rank names and salary grades with the other line agencies of the DILG. This bill seeks to remedy any inconsistency and inequality among the uniformed personnel who are offering the same dedication and level of public service.

This proposed measure also harmonizes rank classification with Republic Act No. 11200 that was enacted on February 2019. RA 11200 provided for the rank classification in the PNP and adopted a more common rank nomenclature in addressing our law enforcers which is aligned to the terminologies of the military, for purposes of clarity of command and responsibility, and for the effective administration, supervision and control of the uniformed personnel of the PNP. It eliminated confusion as to how policemen can be appropriately addressed, as it also paved the way for enhanced interoperability and better coordination.

This bill was reported out by the Senate Committee on Public Order and Dangerous Drugs during the Eighteenth Congress.

In view of the foregoing, approval of this bill is recommended.

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Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. Section 3 of Republic Act No. 9263, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 3. Organization and Key Positions of the BFP and the BJMP. — The BFP and the BJMP shall be respectively headed by a Chief who shall be assisted by two (2) Deputy Chiefs, one (1) for Administration and one (1) for Operations, all of whom shall be appointed by the President upon recommendation of the Secretary of the DILG from among the qualified officers with at least the rank of [senior superintendent] FIRE/JAIL BRIGADIER GENERAL in the service: Provided, That in no case shall any officer who has retired or is retirable within six (6) months from his/her compulsory retirement age be appointed as Chief of the Fire Bureau or Chief of the Jail Bureau, as the case may be:

Provided, further, That the Chief of the Fire Bureau and the Chief of the Jail Bureau shall serve a tour of duty not to exceed four (4) years: *Provided, however*, That in times of war or other national emergency declared by Congress, the President may extend such tour of duty.

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"The heads of the BFP and the BJMP with the rank of [director] FIRE/JAIL GENERAL shall have the position title of Chief of the Fire Bureau and the Chief of the Jail Bureau, respectively. The second officers in command of the BFP and the BJMP with the rank of [chief superintendent] FIRE/JAIL LIEUTENANT GENERAL shall have the position title of Deputy Chief for Administration of the Fire Bureau and Deputy Chief for Administration of the Jail Bureau, respectively. The third officers in command of the BFP and the BJMP with the rank of [chief-superintendent] FIRE/JAIL LIEUTENANT GENERAL shall have the position title of Deputy Chief for Operation of the Fire Bureau and Deputy Chief for Operation of the Jail Bureau, respectively. The fourth officers in command of the BFP and the BJMP with the rank of [chief superintendent] FIRE/JAIL LIEUTENANT GENERAL shall have the position title of Chief of Directorial Staff of the Fire Bureau and Chief of Directorial Staff of the Jail Bureau, who shall be assisted by the Directors of the Directorates in the respective National Headquarters Office with at least the rank of [senior superintendent] FIRE/JAIL MAJOR GENERAL.

"The BFP and the BJMP shall **CONSTRUCT**, establish, operate and maintain their respective regional offices in each of the administrative regions of the country which shall be respectively headed by a Regional Director for Fire Protection and a Regional Director of Jail Management and Penology with the rank of [senior superintendent] **FIRE/JAIL BRIGADIER GENERAL.** He/she shall be respectively

rank of superintendent, who must be a graduate of
Bachelor of Laws or a holder of a Master's Degree in
Public Administration, Management, Engineering,
Public Safety, Criminology or other related disciplines
from a recognized institution of learning, and must
have satisfactorily passed the necessary training or
career courses for such position as may be established
by the Fire Bureau;

"4) District Fire Marshal for the National Capital Region, Regional Director for Fire Protection and Director of the Directorate of the National Headquarters Office. Should have at least the rank of

senior superintendent, who must be a graduate of Bachelor of Laws or a holder of a Master's Degree in Public Administration, Management, Engineering, Public Safety, Criminology or other related disciplines from a recognized institution of learning, and must have satisfactorily passed the necessary training or career courses for such position as may be established by the Fire Bureau;

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"3) DISTRICT FIRE MARSHAL, DISTRICT FIRE MARSHAL FOR THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION, PROVINCIAL FIRE MARSHAL, **FOR** ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR ADMINISTRATION, ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR OPERATIONS AND REGIONAL CHIEF OF DIRECTORIAL STAFF. - SHOULD HAVE THE RANK OF FIRE COLONEL, WHO MUST BE A GRADUATE OF BACHELOR OF LAWS OR A HOLDER OF A MASTER'S DEGREE IN PUBLIC MANAGEMENT, ADMINISTRATION, **ENGINEERING, PUBLIC SAFETY, CRIMINOLOGY** OR OTHER RELATED DISCIPLINES FROM A RECOGNIZED INSTITUTION OF LEARNING, AND MUST HAVE SATISFACTORILY PASSED THE NECESSARY TRAINING OR CAREER COURSES FOR SUCH POSITION AS MAY BE ESTABLISHED BY THE FIRE BUREAU;

"4) REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR FIRE
PROTECTION, ASSISTANT REGIONAL

THE RANK OF FIRE BRIGADIER GENERAL, WHO

MUST BE A GRADUATE OF BACHELOR OF LAWS OR A HOLDER OF A MASTER'S DEGREE IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION, MANAGEMENT, ENGINEERING, PUBLIC SAFETY, CRIMINOLOGY OR OTHER RELATED DISCIPLINES FROM A RECOGNIZED INSTITUTION OF LEARNING, AND MUST HAVE SATISFACTORILY PASSED THE NECESSARY TRAINING OR CAREER COURSES FOR SUCH POSITION AS MAY BE ESTABLISHED BY THE FIRE BUREAU;

THE NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS OFFICE AND REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION. — SHOULD HAVE AT LEAST THE RANK OF FIRE MAJOR GENERAL, WHO MUST BE A GRADUATE OF BACHELOR OF LAWS OR A HOLDER OF A MASTER'S DEGREE IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION, MANAGEMENT, ENGINEERING, PUBLIC SAFETY, CRIMINOLOGY OR OTHER RELATED DISCIPLINES FROM A RECOGNIZED INSTITUTION OF LEARNING, AND MUST HAVE SATISFACTORILY PASSED THE NECESSARY TRAINING OR CAREER COURSES FOR SUCH POSITION AS MAY BE ESTABLISHED BY THE FIRE BUREAU;

"[5)] 6) Deputy Chief for Administration of the Fire Bureau, Deputy Chief for Operations of the Fire Bureau and Chief Directorial Staff of the Fire Bureau.—

Should have the rank of [superintendent] FIRE LIEUTENANT GENERAL, who must be a member of the Philippine Bar or a holder of a Master's Degree in Public Administration, Management, Engineering,

Public Safety, Criminology or other related disciplines from a recognized institution of learning, and must have satisfactorily passed the necessary training or career courses for such as may be established by the Fire Bureau; and,

the rank of [director] **FIRE GENERAL**, who must be a member of the Philippine Bar or a holder of a Master's Degree in Public Administration, Management, Engineering, Public Safety, Criminology or other related disciplines from a recognized institution of learning, and must have satisfactorily passed the necessary training or career courses for such position as may be established by the Fire Bureau.

"No person shall be designated to the following key positions of the BJMP unless he/she has met the qualification provided therein:

- rank of [chicf inspector] JAIL LIEUTENANT COLONEL, who must have finished at least second year Bachelor of Laws or earned at least twelve (12) units in a Master's Degree Program in Management, Public Administration, Public Safety, Criminology, Penology, Sociology, National Security Administration, Defense Studies, or other related disciplines from a recognized institution of learning, and must have satisfactorily passed the necessary training or career courses for such position as may be established by the Fire Bureau;
- "2) *City Jail Warden*. Should have the rank of [chief_inspector] **JAIL COLONEL**, who must have finished at least second year Bachelor of Laws or

earned at least twenty four (24) units in a Master's Management, Public Program in Degree Administration, Public Safety, Criminology, Penology, Sociology, National Security Administration, Defense Studies, or other related disciplines from a recognized institution of learning, and must have satisfactorily passed the necessary training or career courses for such position as may be established by the Fire Bureau: Provided, That in City Jails with a population of one thousand (1,000) or more inmates, the City Jail Warden shall have the rank and qualification of a District Jail Warden;

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- District Jail Warden, Provincial Jail "3) Assistant Regional Director Administrator, Administration, Assistant Regional Director Operations and Regional Chief of Directorial Staff. -Should have the rank of [senior superintendent] JAIL COLONEL, who must be a graduate of Bachelor of Laws or a holder of a Master's Degree in Management, Public Administration, Public Safety, Criminology, Penology, Sociology, National Security Administration, Defense Studies, or other related disciplines from a recognized institution of learning, and must have satisfactorily passed the necessary training or career courses for such position as may be established by the Fire Bureau;
- "4) Regional Director for Jail Management and Penology, [and Directorate of the National Headquarters Office] ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR ADMINISTRATION (NCR) AND ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR OPERATIONS (NCR). Should have the rank of

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GENERAL, who must be a graduate of Bachelor of Laws or a holder of a Master's Degree in Management, Public Administration, Public Safety, Criminology, Penology, Sociology, National Security Administration, Defense Studies, or other related disciplines from a recognized institution of learning, and must have satisfactorily passed the necessary training or career courses for such position as may be established by the Fire Bureau;

"5) DIRECTOR OF THE DIRECTORATE OF THE NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS OFFICE AND REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION. - SHOULD HAVE THE RANK OF JAIL MAJOR GENERAL, WHO MUST BE A GRADUATE OF BACHELOR OF LAWS OR A MASTER'S DEGREE IN HOLDER OF Α MANAGEMENT, PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION, PUBLIC SAFETY, CRIMINOLOGY, PENOLOGY, NATIONAL SECURITY SOCIOLOGY, ADMINISTRATION, DEFENSE STUDIES DISCIPLINES FROM RELATED RECOGNIZED INSTITUTION OF LEARNING, AND MUST HAVE SATISFACTORILY PASSED THE NECESSARY TRAINING OR CAREER COURSES FOR SUCH POSITION AS MAY BE ESTABLISHED BY THE JAIL BUREAU;

"[5] 6) Deputy Chief for Administration of the Jail Bureau, Deputy Chief of Operations of the Jail Bureau and the Chief of Directorial Staff of the Jail Bureau. — Should have the rank of [senior superintendent] JAIL LIEUTENANT GENERAL, who

must a member of the Philippine Bar or a holder of a Master's Degree in Management, Public Administration, Public Safety, Criminology, Penology, Sociology, National Security Administration, Defense Studies, or other related disciplines from a recognized institution of learning, and must have satisfactorily passed the necessary training or career courses for such position as may be established by the Jail Bureau;

"[6)] **7)** Chief of the Jail Bureau. – Should have the rank of [director] **JAIL GENERAL**, who must a member of the Philippine Bar or a holder of a Master's Degree in Management, Public Administration, Public Safety, Criminology, Penology, Sociology, National Security Administration, Defense Studies, or other related disciplines from a recognized institution of learning, and must have satisfactorily passed the necessary training or career courses for such position as may be established by the Jail Bureau;

"[Any uniformed personnel of the BFP and the BJMP who is currently occupying such position but lacks the qualifications mentioned therein shall be given three (3) years upon the effectivity of this Act to comply with the requirements, otherwise he/she shall be relieved from the position.]

"ANY UNIFORMED PERSONNEL OF THE BFP AND
THE BJMP WHO IS CURRENTLY OCCUPYING SUCH
DESIGNATION FOR MORE THAN FIVE (5) YEARS
SHALL BE RECLASSIFIED OF THEIR RANKS BY
OPERATION OF LAW."

Sec. 4. Section 12 of Republic Act No. 9263, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 12. **RANK CLASSIFICATION,** Standardization of the Base Pay, Retirement and other Benefits of the Uniformed Personnel of the BFP and BJMP. — In order to enhance the general welfare, commitment to service and professionalism of the uniformed personnel of the BFP and the BJMP, they shall receive the minimum starting salary equivalent to the salary grade level of the corresponding rank classification of their counterparts in the PNP, as provided under Section 36 of Republic Act No. 8551, and in the AFP, as provided under Section 2 of Republic Act No. 9166.

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"[The rate of the base pay of the uniformed personnel of the BFP and the BJMP shall be adjusted in accordance with the following salary grade schedule:] FOR PURPOSES OF EFFICIENT ADMINISTRATION, SUPERVISION AND CONTROL, THE RANK CLASSIFICATION AND THE CORRESPONDING RATE OF THE BASE PAY OF THE UNIFORMED PERSONNEL OF THE BFP AND BJMP SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

Provided, That all benefits currently received by the uniformed personnel of the BFP and the BJMP under existing laws shall continue to be received by them: *Provided, further,* That their retirement pay shall be subject to the adjustment/s based on the prevailing scale of base pay of the uniformed personnel in the active service.

Sec. 5. *Implementing Rules and Regulations.* – The DILG, in coordination with the BFP and the BJMP, the CSC, the Department of Budget and Management, and the Department of Finance, shall within ninety (90) days from the effectivity of this Act, promulgate the rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this Act.

Sec. 6. *Separability Clause.* – If any provision or part hereof is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the law or the provision or part not otherwise affected shall remain valid and subsisting.

Sec. 7. *Repealing Clause.* — Any law, presidential decree or issuance, executive order, letter of instruction, administrative order, rule, or regulation contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, modified, or amended accordingly.

Sec. 8. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
