AN ACT

DECLARING THE CITY OF SAN JOSE DEL MONTE IN THE PROVINCE OF BULACAN A HUMAN RESOURCE CAPITAL

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. It is hereby declared the policy of the State to promote a just and
 dynamic social order that will ensure the prosperity and independence of the
 nation through policies that promote full employment and affirm labor as a
 primary social force.

SEC. 2. The City of San Jose Del Monte in the Province of Bulacan, a preferred
government site for human relocation, is hereby declared a human resource
capital.

1 SEC. 3. The Department of Labor and Employment, Technical Education and 2 Skills Development Authority, and the Department of Trade and Industry, in 3 coordination with the city government of San Jose Del Monte, shall formulate 4 policies and implement plans and programs for the enhancement of the city's 5 human resources such as the establishment of training centers, the delivery of 6 skills and livelihood training programs, and the promotion of quality technicalvocational education. These plans and programs must be aimed at the 7 development and utilization of the manpower resources from the City of San Jose 8 Del Monte, the promotion of their employment, and acceleration of their 9 10 economic and social growth.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
 Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
