**AN ACT**  
**RATIONALIZING THE DISABILITY PENSION OF VETERANS, AMENDING FOR**  
**THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 6948, ENTITLED, "AN ACT**  
**STANDARDIZING AND UPGRADING THE BENEFITS FOR MILITARY**  
**VETERANS AND THEIR DEPENDENTS," AS AMENDED**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1       **SECTION 1.** Section 5 of Republic Act No. 6948, as amended, is hereby further  
2 amended to read as follows:

3             “Sec. 5. Pension Rates. – A veteran who is disabled owing to sickness,  
4 disease, wounds or injuries sustained in the line of duty shall be given a monthly  
5 disability pension in accordance with the rates prescribed hereunder [, unless he is  
6 actually receiving a similar pension for the same disability from other government  
7 funds or the United States Government;]:  
8

9             “(a) If and while the disability is rated anywhere from ten to thirty per centum (10% -  
10 30%), the monthly pension shall be [One thousand pesos (P1,000.00)] **FOUR**  
11 **THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P4,500.00);**

13             “(b) If and while the disability is rated anywhere from thirty-one to forty per centum  
14 (31% - 40%), the monthly pension shall be [One thousand one hundred pesos  
15 (P1,100.00)] **FIVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED PESOS (P5,300.00);**

17             “(c) If and while the disability is rated anywhere from forty-one to fifty per centum  
18 (41% - 50%), the monthly pension shall be [One thousand two hundred pesos  
19 (P1,200.00)] **SIX THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED PESOS (P6,100.00);**

21             “(d) If and while the disability is rated anywhere from fifty-one to sixty per centum  
22 (51% - 60%), the monthly pension shall be [One thousand three hundred pesos  
23 (P1,300.00)] **SIX THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED PESOS (P6,900.00);**

25             “(e) If and while the disability is rated anywhere from sixty-one to seventy per centum  
26 (61% - 70%), the monthly pension shall be [One thousand four hundred pesos  
27 (P1,400.00)] **SEVEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED PESOS (P7,700.00);**

1       “(f) If and while the disability is rated anywhere from seventy-one to eighty per  
2       centum (71% - 80%), the monthly pension shall be [One thousand five hundred pesos  
3       (P1,500.00)] **EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P8,500.00);**

5       “(g) If and while the disability is rated anywhere from eighty-one to ninety per  
6       centum (81% - 90%), the monthly pension shall be [One thousand six hundred pesos  
7       (P1,600.00)] **NINE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED PESOS (P9,300.00);**

9       “(h) If and while the disability is rated anywhere from ninety-one to one hundred per  
10      centum (91% - 100%), the monthly pension shall be [One thousand seven hundred  
11      pesos (P1,700.00)] **TEN THOUSAND PESOS (P10,000.00);** plus [Five hundred  
12      pesos (P500.00)] **ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00)** for the spouse and each  
13      unmarried minor children: *Provided*, That a veteran, [with or] without a service-  
14      connected [or non-service connected] disability, upon reaching the age of seventy (70)  
15      is deemed totally disabled [with one hundred per centum (100%) rating] and shall be  
16      entitled to a monthly pension of One thousand seven hundred pesos (P1,700.00)  
17      **ONLY:** [plus Five hundred pesos (P500.00) for the spouse and each unmarried minor  
18      children.] **PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT THE ENTITLEMENT TO THE**  
19      **DISABILITY PENSION AUTHORIZED HEREIN SHALL BE PROSPECTIVE**  
20      **AND LIMITED TO ELIGIBLE LIVING VETERANS ONLY.”**

22       **SEC. 2.** The initial amount necessary for the implementation of this Act shall be  
23      charged against the Pension and Gratuity Fund. Thereafter, such sums as may be needed for  
24      the continued implementation of this Act shall be included in the annual General  
25      Appropriations Act.

26       **SEC. 3.** If any part or provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the  
27      remainder of this <sup>Act</sup> or any affected thereby shall remain in force and effect.

28       **SEC. 4.** All existing laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act  
29      are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

30       **SEC. 5.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*  
31      *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
