The Committees on Justice and Human Rights; and Constitutional Amendments, Revision of Codes and Laws to which were referred Senate Bill No. 64, introduced by Senator Flavier, entitled:

ALLOWING NATURAL-BORN CITIZENS OF THE PHILIPPINES WHO
HAVE LOST THEIR CITIZENSHIP TO RETAIN CERTAIN RIGHTS AND

ACQUIRED’ AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NUMBERED ONE
