The Secretary. Senate Bill No. 180, entitled:

AN ACT AMENDING ARTICLE 7 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 209, THE FAMILY CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES, BY RESTORING TO MAYORS OF CITIES AND MUNICIPALITIES THE POWER TO SOLEMNIZE MARRIAGE.
